NEW ORGANIZATION OF GERMAN BOARD BIRDSTRIKE PREVENTION

Since january 1981 the German Board "Birdstrike Prevention" has a new legally binding form and defined its tasks in articles as follows:

- 1. Experience exchange and evaluation of birdstrike-reports for improvement of knowledge about birdstrike-risk
- 2. Planning, organization and realization of corresponding research and investigation program
- 3. Contact and cooperation with scientific institutes and environmental authorities
- 4. Cooperation at ecological reports about airports and its surroundings
- 5. Organization of ecological instructions
- 6. Motivation of authorities and of aviation personal by special instructions, publications, comments and informations
- 7. Scientific advisory of civil and military aviation
- 8. Observation, checking and analysis of all biological circumstances and processes which will have influence on flight safety
- 9. Advisory of international aviation-, federal- and regional authorities at birdstrike problem and at introduction of new standards and flight safety recommendations
- 10. Public relations
- ll. Card index of incidents/accidents and statistics
- 12. Evaluation of literature for practical use
- 13. Representation in national and international committees

Members of the board are:

- One representative of the federal republic of Germany
- One representative of the Deutsche Lufthansa
- Two representatives of insurance agencies
- Some biological experts whose profession touches flight safety or aviation problems
- Some airport experts
- Some engineers

Moreover some f ederal authorities will send technical experts who

are not official members of the board. Generally only such persons can acquire the membership in the board who are able to promote birdstrike - flight safety by their profession.
