1. In the Green Booklet, 3rd edition, May 1988, para, 2.2.1, you will find rules regarding the existence of trees and bushes in the vicinity of airports.

- In accordance with EEC Council Directive 797/85, farmers under certain conditions are entitled to a grant to change arable land into forests.
- 3. The objective of this EEC Council Directive might be opposed to the work performed by the airport to minimize the risk of bird strikes as indicated under para. 1 where certain restrictions as to the presence of trees and bushes in the neighbourhood of airports are found.
- 4. Consequently, the participants to the meeting are urged to ask the appropriate authorities to take into account when approving regulations for turning anable land into forests that a working forestry programme on or near airport should play a secondary role to the airport priorities in the interest of flight safety.
