2.8. Bird Hazard Maps Europe.

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Proposal for Bird Hazard Maps Europe (by Dr.J. Hild, GAF)

- 1. A collection of preliminary bird hazard maps is finished. GAF will send copies of all maps within the next months together with a comesponding description.
- 2. In order to guarantee that pilots get a most possible information from these maps GAF proposes the following:
 - a) To publish the maps in the AIP and/or the DOD insofar/facts are interesting.
 - b) To take informations of these maps which are possibly interesting for airfields and airports and publish it according the German catalogue of air trafic station(sample), and
 - c) To draft a larger bird hazard map, scale 1: 2.000.000, perhaps saisonal maps on the basis of national maps for information at weather office and BASOPS
 - d) To build a small group within Bird Movement Working Group to discuss the a.m. problems and to work up drafts in order to get a discussion background for the next meeting of Bird Movement working Group which will be held in spring 1973.

The small group should consist of 1 representative of Civil Aviation, 1 representative of military aviation and 1 biologist.

First meeting of the small group is provided for autumn 1972 in Cologne.
