5. Main themes:

No main theme for BSCE 16 has been decided. However, since we this time will be working in close cooperation with the Ornithological Congress it seems suitable for our meeting to deal with the bird problems in an even more specific way compared to earlier meetings. That means for instance bird's life in and around an airport, concentration areas, local bird movements and bird's migration, etc. It must also be stressed that rather little time will be available for presentations at the Plenary (only policy papers) so the majority of papers will have to be presented at the meetings of working groups.
